Wed 26 February

Scriptures: Isaiah 32:9-18; Jeremiah 9:17-21; Psalm 103:8-14

- Praise, worship and thank God for His multiple blessings and unfailing mercies towards Britain.
- Consecrate yourself to God and ask Him to cleanse you from any sin and fill you afresh with His Spirit.
- Ask the Holy Spirit to give you strength and guide you as you pray.
- Pray for the women of the UK to hear the call of Jesus and be encouraged to respond and draw nearer to Him in prayer. Pray that they receive the love of Jesus and hear His heart and burden for their nation

Thu 27 February

Scriptures: Zechariah 3:1-5; Revelation 3:14-22; 1 John 1:1-10

- Pray and repent on behalf of the entire CHURCH in Britain.
- Ask the Father to bring us to the place of humility, brokenness and repentance.
- Acknowledge our sins as the Church, that we have not always walked in the Way, the Truth and the Life; that we have not been the salt and light of our communities and society
- Acknowledge that we have been complacent, apathetic and often indifferent.
- Repent and ask God to forgive the Church and cleanse her from every sin.

Fri 28 February

Scriptures: 2 Samuel 23:1-4; Romans 13:1-7; 1 Timothy 2:1-5

- Thank God for the men and women who serve our nation in government.
- Pray and repent on behalf of previous and current governments on the UK:
 - For gradually and progressively moving the nation away from God.
 - For passing ungodly laws that contradict the Word of God, and lead us away from His ways
 - For not always considering the poor, needy and destitute.
- Pray for God to have mercy and forgive our government and restore the fear of God to them.

Sat 29 February

Scriptures: Judges 2:10-12; Daniel 9:8-10; Zechariah 12:10-14; Romans 3:21-26

- Pray and repent on behalf of the PEOPLE of Britain:
 - For their rebellion in turning away from the word, laws and ways of God.
 - For philosophies and ideologies that have led people astray and away from God (atheism, modernism, post-modernism, existentialism, etc).
 - Not seeking the true God, but seeking after other gods and mammon.
 - For not raising the next generation to know God.

- Ask God to have mercy on the UK and forgive us our sins and all our works of unrighteousness.

Sun 1 March

Scriptures: Joel 2:28-29; John 14:1-1; Acts 1:4-5,8;

- Praise and thank God for His love for Britain.
- Pray for revival, that God would visit this land again, by pouring out His Spirit afresh upon us.
- Pray that there would be a mighty move of the Holy Spirit in this land, turning the hearts of people back to God - His word, worship and ways.
- Pray that many would come to experience the love of God through Jesus Christ.

Mon 2 March

Scriptures: Joshua 1:8; John 1:1-5, 14; 2 Timothy 2:15

- Pray for revival, a fresh move of the Holy Spirit in this land.
- Repent on behalf of the Church for departing from the truth of God's Word
- Repent for our unbelief, doubt, lack of faith, apathy, indifference and disobedience to the Word of God.
- Thank God for making the scriptures available to our generation in its richest formats and variety, and abundance.
- Pray that God would give us the grace to read and study the Bible.

Tue 3 March

Scriptures: 1 John 1:1-4; Ezra 7:10; Zechariah 3:6-10; John 14:26

- Pray for revival, a fresh move of the Holy Spirit in this land.
- Pray that Church leaders would actually read, study and obey the Bible, the Word of God.
- Pray that believers would begin to read, study and obey the Word of God
- Pray for the Holy Spirit, our Teacher, to give understanding, knowledge and wisdom, as people read and study the Word.

Wed 4 March

Scriptures: Isaiah 32:9-19; John 8:32, 36; Song of Solomon 2:14

- God is calling on women to pray and intercede for the UK.
- Pray that God will deal with any stronghold that hinders women from responding to His call.
- Pray that women would come out of complacency, apathy and fear, and become more proactive in prayer and sharing the Gospel with others.
- Pray that more and more women will begin to pray for this nation.

Thu 5 March

Scriptures: Romans 10:17; Ephesians 1:15-22; Colossians 1:15-17

- Pray for revival, a fresh move of the Holy Spirit in this land.
- Pray that our FAITH in God would increase through the Word.
- Pray that through the Word of God, Jesus Christ and His Kingdom would be revealed afresh to the Church.
- Pray that as we grow to know Jesus more, we will be empowered to rise up as His Body and Bride.

Fri 6 March

Scriptures: Ezra 7:10; 2 Timothy 2:15;

- Pray for revival, a fresh move of the Holy Spirit in this land.
- Pray that our Church Leaders would uphold and set the truth of God's word as a standard for life.
- Pray that Christians would believe, obey and practise what the Bible says.
- Pray that Christians would begin to live the kingdom lifestyle by believing, obeying and practising (doing) the Word of God.

Sat 7 March

Scriptures: Joel 2:28-29; Acts 2:1-4; Acts 2:14-47

- Pray for a fresh outpouring of the Holy Spirit upon the Church.
- Pray that God would stir up a passion and burden in us for the lost.
- Pray that we would be stirred up by the Holy Spirit to step out to share the Gospel with others.
- Pray that the Holy Spirit would give us courage, wisdom and the words to use when sharing the Gospel.

Sun 8 March

Scriptures: Mark 16:15-18; Acts 4:23-31; 1 Corinthians 12:4-11

- Pray for a fresh outpouring of the Holy Spirit upon the Church.
- Pray that Christians would not fear, but have the boldness to preach/share the Gospel with others.
- Pray that as we do so, God would stretch forth His hand with signs and wonders - healings, deliverances, etc.
- Pray that the gifts of the Holy Spirit would be manifested in and through the Church.

Mon 9 March

Scriptures: John 16:7-11; Acts 2:37-41; 2 Corinthians 4:4; Acts 8:4-8

- Pray for revival, a fresh move of the Holy Spirit in this land.
- Pray that as we share the Gospel with others, the Holy Spirit would convict them of sin, righteousness and judgement, and they would repent.
- Pray that the god of this world is bound, so that the people will see the light of the glorious gospel of Jesus Christ.
- Pray that many people will come to know the joy, peace and comfort that is found in Jesus Christ. Pray for especially your family, friends and neighbours who are unsaved.

Tue 10 March

Scriptures: 2 Corinthians 10:4-6; Acts 5:11-14; Acts 10:34-48

- Pray for revival, a fresh move of the Holy Spirit in this land.
- Pray against idolatry, materialism, worldliness, etc, and all that stop people from receiving the gospel and responding to it.
- Pray that the hearts of people would be turned to the Lord in repentance, and many souls would be saved.
- Pray that the fear of God and righteousness would be restored, as people turn to the Lord.

Wed 11 March

Scriptures: Isaiah 32:9-18; John 8:32, 36; Galatians 3:26-29

- Pray that women in the UK would come to know the truth of God's word concerning who we are in Christ.
- Pray that we would spend more time reading and studying the scriptures.
- Pray that we would grow stronger in faith and step out to be used by God.
- Pray that we would be more proactive in sharing what we are learning with others, and helping each other to grow.

Thu 12 March

Scriptures: Matthew 6:10; Isaiah 9:6-7; Isaiah 33:22; Isaiah 62:10

- Pray for revival, a fresh move of the Holy Spirit in this land.
- Pray and declare: Thy Kingdom come, Thy will be done on earth and in Britain, as it is in heaven.
- Ask God to truly become the Judge, Lawgiver and King of the UK.
- Pray that the banner of Jesus Christ shall fly above our nation and many shall be drawn to Him.

Fri 13 March

Scriptures: Psalm 2; Romans 14:17; 2 Corinthians 10:4-6; Ephesians 6:12

- Pray for revival, a fresh move of the Holy Spirit in this land.
- Pray, “Thy Kingdom – righteousness, peace and joy in the Holy Spirit – COME!”
- Pray against the ideologies and philosophies of the government and people, e.g. social liberal humanism, atheism, pluralism and moral relativism, etc, which work against the Kingdom of God in the UK.
- Pray that through the Church, and by the Spirit, truth shall be revealed to this nation again.

Sat 14 March

Scriptures: 1 Timothy 2:1-4; Proverbs 21:1-3; 2 Samuel 23:1-4;

- Pray for revival, a fresh move of the Holy Spirit in this land.
- Pray that the Prime Minister and his cabinet would govern in a righteous way.
- Pray for wisdom, unity and moral strength for the government to make godly decisions that would benefit the people.
- Pray that the opposition will hold the government to account in a godly way.
- Pray that MPs, especially Christian MPs, would pursue God's Kingdom agenda – righteousness, peace and joy – above their individual party agenda and loyalty.

Sun 15 March

Scriptures: 2 Kings 23:2-4; 1 Timothy 2:1-4; Psalm 72:1-7

- Pray for revival, a fresh move of the Holy Spirit in this land.
- Pray that the fear of God shall be restored to the government and people of the UK.
- Pray in particular that the Government would revisit and amend some of the laws that are ungodly, including marriage and abortion.
- Pray that the government would pursue a righteousness agenda that would bring peace and joy to the people of the UK, especially, children, the poor, needy and destitute .

Mon 16 March

Scriptures: 1 Timothy 2:1-4; Psalm 21:1-7; Psalm 72:1-7

- Pray for revival, a fresh move of the Holy Spirit in this land.
- Pray for the royal family
- Pray for the Queen, that God would continue to bless and strengthen her
- Pray that the Queen would continue to be a witness to Jesus Christ
- Pray that her family – husband, children, grandchildren and great grandchildren – shall all be saved

Tue 17 March

Scriptures: Haggai 2:1-5; 2 Timothy 1:7; Ephesians 6:10-20

- Pray for revival, a fresh move of the Holy Spirit in this land.
- Pray for all those praying and standing in the gap for Britain at this time.
- Pray against fear, discouragement and infirmity.
- Pray for an increase in strength and faith, as we all read the scriptures and pray.
- Pray for the presence of the Holy Spirit, and God's protection and peace over His people.

Wed 18 March

Scriptures: Isaiah 32:9-18; Numbers 27:1-7; Joshua 17:3-6; Psalm 2:8

- Pray for revival, a fresh move of the Holy Spirit among women in the UK.
- Pray against the things that hinder Christian women from rising up – fear, ignorance, apathy, complacency, indifference, etc.
- Pray for the women of Britain to rise up and boldly come before God, and ask Him for this nation as a possession and inheritance.
- Pray that we would be stirred up and rise up to pray and intercede for our families, communities, villages and towns and the UK.

Thu 19 March

Scriptures: Deuteronomy 4:1-10; Proverbs 22:6; 2 Corinthians 4:4

- Pray for revival, a fresh move of the Holy Spirit in this land.
- Thank God for the UK's great and outstanding educational institutions.
- Repent on behalf of these institutions for moving away from the standard and truth of the Word of God.
- Repent on behalf of these institution for replacing the word with science and ungodly ideologies and philosophies.
- Pray that God would restore the truth to the heads of our educational institutions.

Fri 20 March

Scriptures: 2 Timothy 3:13-17; Ephesians 6:12; 2 Corinthians 10:4-6

- Pray for revival, a fresh move of the Holy Spirit in this land.
- Continue to pray for our educational institutions.
- Pray against the demonic agenda to brainwash our children and the youth, through ungodly curriculums that teach all sorts of untruths.
- Pray for the Education Secretary, heads of schools and chancellors and deans of universities, teachers, lecturers, etc, to come to know Jesus Christ.

Sat 21 March

Scriptures: Isaiah 11:1-2; Micah 4:1-5; Proverbs 22:6

- Pray for revival in our educational institutions, a fresh move of God to restore truth and turn the youth back to the word and ways of God.
- Pray that the bible would be read in our schools again.
- Pray that our schools and universities would be directed by biblical values and high moral standards.
- Pray for an effective and influential Christian Union in our universities.
- Pray for our pupils and students to come to faith in Jesus Christ

Sun 22 March

Scriptures: Genesis 1:26-29; Genesis 2:18-24; Matthew 6:12; 1 John 1:8-10

- Pray for marriages and families in the UK
- Repent on behalf of this nation for deviating from biblical definitions of marriage and family and creating our own definitions
- Repent for the ungodly laws that have been enacted against the word of God
- Repent for the increase in divorce and broken families, especially within the Church
- Pray that God would have mercy on us and forgive us.

Mon 23 March

Scriptures: Isaiah 9:6-7; Malachi 2:13-16; Matthew 19:1-9

- Pray for revival, a fresh move of the Holy Spirit in this land.
- Pray that we would have strong marriages and families in the UK
- Pray for the government to make policies and laws that would support strong marriages and families.
- Pray that as revival comes and people are transformed this will have an impact on marriage and family.
- Praise and thank God for restoring marriage and family in the UK.

Tue 24 March

Scriptures: 2 Corinthians 4:4; Deuteronomy 8:11-18; Exodus 20:8-11

- Thank God for a thriving economy, business community, financial institutions and media.
- Repent on behalf of the business community for not following biblical principles in business and being guided by greed and the love of money.
- Repent on their behalf for putting pressure on the government to make ungodly laws, e.g. Sunday trading, tax laws, agricultural practices, etc.
- Pray that the fear of God would be restored in the business community, financial institutions and media.

Wed 25 March

Scriptures: 1 Timothy 6:10; James 5:1-6; Revelation 3:14-22

- Pray for revival, a fresh move of the Holy Spirit in this land.
- Continue to pray for the business community, financial institutions and media.
- Pray against greed, lust for power and status, corruption, selfishness, pride, injustice, ambition, etc
- Pray for the godly and positive influence of God's people in all areas of business, finance and the media,
- Pray that biblical truth and moral values would be restored, and many will come to faith in Jesus Christ

Thu 26 March

Scriptures: Isaiah 32:9-18; Psalm 45:10-15; Exodus 15:20-21; Judges 5:6-7,24-27

- Pray that God would stir up passion in the women of Britain.
- Pray for unity among women, that the barriers and dividing walls would come down
- Pray that we would be strong in the love of Jesus for us and our love for Him
- Pray that we would be strong in love for one another and in unity
- Pray that in love and unity we would rise up and be used by God to bring change to this nation.

Fri 27 March

Scriptures: Jeremiah 9:17-21; Matthew 5:13-16; Isaiah 49:24-25; Isaiah 54:13

- Pray for revival, a fresh move of the Holy Spirit among the youth
- Pray against the things that work against the youth, e.g. drugs, gang crimes, murder, alcoholism, etc.
- Pray for stronger families in which the youth would grow and thrive
- Pray that the Church would be more proactive in reaching out to the next generation.
- Pray for the next generation to come to the saving knowledge of Jesus Christ.

Sat 28 March

Scriptures: Daniel 5:14; Daniel 6:3; Psalm 144:9-15

- Pray for revival, a fresh move of the Holy Spirit among the youth
- Pray for the mental health of the youth.
- Pray that the government would make policies that protect and preserve the youth.
- Pray that the youth shall excel in education and in their careers and professions, etc
- Pray that God would raise strong godly leaders among the youth

Sun 29 March

Scriptures: Deuteronomy 15:11; 24:14; Psalm 82:3-4; Galatians 2:9-11

- Pray for revival, a fresh move of the Holy Spirit in the land.
- Pray for the poor, destitute and needy, and strangers.
- Pray that the government would make policies that support the poor and needy.
- Pray that the Church shall be proactive in reaching out to the poor and needy.
- Pray that these would come to experience the love of God through Jesus Christ.

Mon 30 March

Scriptures: Haggai 2:1-9; 2 Timothy 1:7; Romans 1:16; Isaiah 40:3-9

- Pray for revival, a fresh move of the Holy Spirit in the land.
- There are very challenging times ahead, especially after Brexit. Pray that we would know, indeed, that God is with us, and shall not fear, be discouraged or dismayed.
- Pray that rather, the Church shall be strong in the power and might of God.
- Pray that the Church shall be strong and bold in the Spirit, to reach out to community and society with the hope and joy of the Gospel.

Tue 31 March

Scriptures: Psalm 25; Psalm 33:10-12; Deuteronomy 4:7-8

- Pray against any plans, plots and schemes to undermine and destabilise the UK. Pray especially against dissention, division and fearmongering.
- Pray for God's help to minimise any negative impact of Brexit on our nation, especially, economic hardship.
- Pray for UNITY – that God would heal the divisions that Brexit has caused.
- Pray that the UK shall learn, once again, to put our trust in God.

Wed 1 April

Scriptures: Isaiah 61:1-4; Matthew 28:18-20; Mark 16:15-18; Acts 1:4-5,8

- Pray for Christian women to rise up and prayerfully and proactively watch over their families, communities, society and the nation.
- Pray for God to raise Christian women leaders who would stand as leaders, salt and light and ambassadors, in their communities and society.
- Pray for unity as Christian women come together in prayer and to take action
- Pray that women, together with men, shall fulfil the Great Commission in Britain.

Thu 2 April

Scriptures: Haggai 2:1-9; Ephesians 3:14-21; Ephesians 6:10-20

- Pray that the Body of Christ would be strengthened to stand in these days.
- Pray that both leadership and laity shall grow/stand strong in the HOLY SPIRIT
- Pray that both leadership and laity shall grow/stand strong in the WORD.
- Pray that both leadership and laity shall grow/stand strong in PRAYER
- Pray that both leadership and laity shall grow/stand strong in WORSHIP
- Pray that both leadership and laity shall grow/stand strong in LOVE

Fri 3 April

Scriptures: Micah 4:1-5; Matthew 5:13-16; 1 Timothy 2:1-6

- Pray for revival, a fresh move of the Holy Spirit in this land.
- Pray that Church shall become SALT and LIGHT to our nation, at this time.
- Pray that the Church shall have a stronger influence on our government, business and educational institutions, media and the youth.
- Pray for the Church's authority and influence to increase and spread to all areas of society, culture and nation.
- Pray that through the Church, the glory of God shall rest on Britain again.

Sat 4 April

Scriptures: Isaiah 62; Isaiah 60:1-3; 1 John 5:14-15

- Ask Jesus Christ to take over our nation and cause His glory to shine on us.
- Declare several times *“Thy Kingdom come, Thy will be done in Britain as it is in heaven!”*
- Thank God for every prayer said during these 40 days of prayer for revival in the UK
- Ask God to bless everyone who took part in the 40 days of prayer
- Declare our confidence in the Lord to answer our prayers, and thank Him.

Sun 5 April

Scriptures: Psalm 85; Ezekiel 47:1-12; Psalm 66:16-20; Mark 11:20-24

- Praise God that the Church shall be strong to lift Jesus Christ as the only Saviour, Light and Source of Hope to our nation.
- Praise God that His redemptive power would be demonstrated through the Church, in signs and wonders, as we preach and share the Gospel.
- Praise God that many shall be saved and delivered
- Praise God that His Kingdom – righteousness, peace and joy – will flourish once again in Britain
- Praise, thank and God! Rejoice and be glad for answered prayers.
