On 31 March 2013, the Lord spoke to me in a dream and later gave me a message for the Church in the United Kingdom, which I shared far and wide. The voice of your watchmen—they lift up their voice; together they sing for joy; for eye to eye they see the return of the Lord to Zion." - Isaiah 52:7-8
