


Introduction




- ◆ To raise strong and God-fearing women of the Spirit, Word and Prayer, who recognise God's voice and obey it.

- ◆ To go into the nations and raise 'labourers' who will fulfil the Great Commission, as well as, mobilise prayer for the nations.





Our Strategy
