Beginning The Journey

The Lord had given a basic vision based on Isaiah 61:1-4, which we were to run with, and restore, raise and empower women to know, love and serve Jesus. Little did we know or anticipate how far the journey would take us and the challenges we would face on the way. We knew, however, that God had called us, was with us, and would not fail us.

As an apostolic ministry, the growth and expansion of WIT, since then, has been steady, effective, consistent, dynamic and unabated. This is because the focus of WIT has been on developing a firm relationship with Jesus Christ and building character, strength, integrity and excellence in women.



Actually, during the early years, our slogan was, "Women In Tune, Listening And Obeying." With each passing year, the ministry is not only transforming lives and stirring up passion for the things of God in both women and men, but also, emerging and evolving into a powerful and effectual instrument in the Lord's hand.

Like Abraham, we took off, not quite knowing where the journey would take us, but confident that God would show us the way. My Name is Apostle Christine Margaret Lwere, Country Director for WOMEN IN TUNE Uganda. I have been part of Women In Tune since 2009 to date.

The WIT President, Apostle Wallace, came to Uganda at a time when I was rising up as a women leader in the nation and I was working with most of the outstanding Women's Ministries in the country. When I heard the message, it caught my attention because I had been struggling with some of the things being taught to women, but I had no solution either. It was a very frustrating situation. I loved helping myself and other women but I was clueless.

Then God brought WIT to Uganda! When we started planning for the first conference in 2009, I had no idea what God had in store for me and other women in this. I thought it was another women's event and the good thing was that Apostle Wallace sponsored it 100%. She did a one-week seminar using her FREE TO SERVE Manual. She handled the most sensitive and painful topics affecting women generally which no other person had ever taught me. Such topics included; Culture, Cage of Fear, Truth about Submission, Redemption of women, women's status as Sons of God and many other issues. I immediately identified the problem in our teachings and why we were not breaking through in Ministry. I have never turned back.

It has been a very difficult but fulfilling journey of selfdiscovery and helping others to do the same. We started by having prayer meetings once a month just to deal with the strongholds in prayer and then going through the Nation teaching other women the new found freedom.

Unfortunately, many women have fought the message so much because it contradicts much of what they are teaching. It has been a very hard ground which requires a lot of prayer and resilience to continue with the work. In my own church pastors started teaching culture again, as a way of discipling me not to make women rebel. The confrontation has been very real.

It has been a very lonely journey but I give God all the glory for His faithful servant Apostle Wallace for constantly checking on us by calling, emails, triennial conferences and retreats just to encourage us stay on truck. I now value salvation and respect people who pave the way for others. Apostle Wallace has been a very good example to me, especially, when I see the pain that she constantly goes through for the sake of the work of God and not giving up. She is like Apostle Paul in many ways. I call her my Apostle because she has role modelled true apostleship to me. I too have determined by God's Grace to fight on until women are free to serve alongside men, without being prejudiced. A lot of changes have taken place in Uganda and many women have been taught the truth of God's word through the manuals Apostle Wallace provided for this work.

We have more than 150 women who have gone through our training and are teaching the same message in their circles. The work has started to be exciting and we believe that soon Uganda will experience a revival because of the message of WIT.

I am a true testimony to what God has done through WIT to change my mindset which has greatly improved my marriage, family, ministry and the nation at large. Long Live WOMEN IN TUNE, Long Live Apostle Jennifer Abigail Lawson-Wallace. For God and My Country.




Prayer and Intercession

My Journey With WIT: A Daughter's Perspective

The Past

I was nine soon to be ten years old when Women In Tune was launched in our home by my parents Apostle Jennifer and Rev Cobby. I remember the day vaguely, there were people sitting in our living room, they sang, they prayed and my mother shared the vision. No doubt my brother Richard and I sat there bored, as we would have preferred to be playing or watching TV or doing anything else a nine year old and six year old would've been interested in at the time. We were too young to have understood a vision with the gravitas and weight of Women In Tune, but with time, maturity and experience this changed.

Growing up I had no real in-depth understanding of the ministry and I was uninterested in getting involved; as can be the case sometimes of children with parents in leadership (Pastors, Apostles, Prophets etc). However, I was grateful for the fact our parents also had no desire to force or coerce us into serving in the ministry. I believe my mum knew deep down that I would eventually 'come'. I am grateful because during those years I had the space to mature within the things of God, without too many glaring eyes on me. Essentially my brother and I were 'shielded' by our parents where ministry was concerned and as a result, we desired to know Jesus and to serve Him through autonomy, understanding, knowledge and a personal relationship with Him, rather than through obligation or trying to please our parents.

It is through this personal relationship with Jesus Christ that I later felt the 'pull', the 'call' the 'responsibility' and the sense of 'purpose' to serve within WIT. The Lord spoke to me personally in 2019 and opened my eyes to see just how great the ministry was. I saw the magnitude of the work and resources, I

observed my mum, Apostle Jennifer's determination, focus, passion, tenacity and love for Jesus and His people, I observed how women's lives were being impacted and transformed; it all blew my mind. Internally, the Holy Spirit was also developing a sense of urgency and responsibility for me to obtain my spiritual inheritance within the ministry, and it was a feeling too great for me to ignore. That's a whole story in itself; perhaps I will share another time

The Present

Now I can say I proudly serve within Women In Tune in a communications, publications and administrative capacity and not only that, I am the Women In Tune Youth Leader for the UK, as I have a heart for the Youth. Within three years God has moulded and shaped me through this ministry. I have grown in the Word, in prayer, in confidence and grown in my understanding of the Great Commission. I have grown in my understanding of purpose and believe I am walking in the will of God. I have developed life and professional skills that I could never have gained elsewhere and have experienced 'iron sharpening' from the women of WIT and WITY. The journey to me getting to this place hasn't always been smooth, and I am still growing, but it has been fruitful and I couldn't imagine my life without being a part of WIT.

Women In Tune changes people's lives. It's as simple as that. I observed it growing up and experienced it for myself as an adult. You don't reach 20 years as a ministry if you are not truly impacting lives with the message of the Gospel. And it is a true testament to the leadership of Apostle Jennifer.

This is a lasting work, which is why God has taken His time to lay a solid and deep foundation, and in 2022 He's saying it's now time to build. After 20 years it is now time to build?! Wow! I can only imagine how many generations of lives this ministry will touch.

Lord may you continue to bless and establish WIT. May the light of Christ continue to shine upon and through the ministry. Thank you Lord for your faithfulness, grace, mercy and love towards our family and this ministry. We honour you, in Jesus' Name.

Let The Truth Be Told






Resources





A Young Woman's Journey With Women In Tune

Having been a part of Women In Tune for 5 years; I have endless stories to tell about how greatly WIT has personally impacted my walk with the Lord. I joined the ministry in 2017. Encountering WIT and their passion for the Lord Jesus Christ made me realize that my understanding of who Christ is, my identity, and my purpose in Him was very limited. WIT had something special. They radiated the glory of Christ! God's presence wasn't only something that they only talked about, it was evident! I desired to be part of that and that's how I ended up becoming a Woman In Tune.

Discipleship

There is a lot that I can point out but let me pick out just a few. Being a woman In Tune and walking the journey opened a great door for me to be discipled. As a young woman, and not having been properly rooted in things pertaining to the Kingdom, I knew very little about the basics of what really being a Christian meant. Who God is and how I am supposed to relate to Him. Who Christ is and who I am in Him. Who the Holy Spirit is and how am I supposed to corporate with Him in day-to-day life as a believer?

"If the purpose of a thing isn't known, it can be misused" Now, as a young woman, I am walking in awareness of my identity and purpose in Christ.

As we become rooted and grow, then we build others and the Kingdom grows.

Love

Love for Christ and one another is evident. One can easily sense a deep and genuine concern amongst team members. The love for Christ among the women and desire to grow in love and in fellowship. It extends deeply from the ministry to individuals which creates a conducive environment for spiritual growth.



The Spirit Of Excellence

The Spirit of excellence in women in Tune is like a mark that never fades. There is grace to give the best in whatever is at hand. Going past barriers, learning, and exercising a spirit of excellence like Daniel! (Daniel 5:12)

Devotion to Christ

A deep devotion to Christ defines Women In Tune. Having and knowing Christ as the head of the church. There is a continued desire to please the Lord, have communion with Him, and continually be transformed to His image. Having an unwavering zeal for the matters of the Kingdom. There is a consistent urge to be drawn to the place of a personal encounter with the Lord Jesus, far deeper beyond the general knowledge of who the Lord is. As we get yielded to Him, then obedience and response to His Kingdom assignments become a lifestyle.

Thanks so much our dear Mom Apostle Jennifer Wallace for the love and effort, may the Lord bless you and reward you.




Training The Trainer Programme

Humanitarian Actions

For example, in 2021, the COVID-19 crises in Uganda caused the government to lockdown the country, causing churches, businesses and public transport to come to a standstill; which created a desperate situation for many. Not only did WIT mobilise earnest prayer and fasting; we also mobilised resources to provide food for over 500 families.

WIT has also helped many individuals, families and communities during times of crisis, including paying the school fees of children and shipping used clothing for distribution among the poor. WIT is always ready to step in and act or help whenever there is a need.





Economic Empowerment

WIT also seeks to empower women financially and economically, through small business initiatives as well as vocational and literacy training. Through the Cedars House Education Fund, women have received sponsorship to further education. WIT has also started small businesses and farming projects to empower women financially. We are trusting God that He will enable us to do this more effectively and enable us to help more women.
