Traditionally, the ‘train-the-trainer’ model is used to train trainers so that they can then teach others effectively



Our vision is a global army of women, faithfully worshipping and serving Jesus Christ. Therefore, the Training The Trainer Programme is a strategy to recruit, restore, raise, reignite and release women as Kingdom leaders to serve the Lord Jesus Christ in their communities and in the nations.

- RECRUIT: enlist, as in the armed forces.
- RESTORE: return (someone or something) to a former condition, place, or position.
- RAISE: lift or move to a higher position or level.
- REIGNITE: spark and cause to have fire and power again.
- RELEASE: allow or enable to escape from confinement; set free.



INTRODUCTION



TWO-PRONGED GOAL

1. Firstly, to train faithful women who will also go out and teach others about the truths of God's Kingdom. Through our TTTP, we aim to help restore women's identity and purpose in Christ; empower them through the word, to know the Lord Jesus; train them as servant-leaders in His Kingdom; activate them through prayer and a fresh encounter with the Holy Spirit, and release them to serve the Lord.
2. The second goal of the Training The Trainer Programme is to offer women an opportunity for accreditation or ordination in ministry; through our partnership and affiliation with Churches In Communities International, a UK based organisation that facilitates accreditation through accountability.



The Training The Trainer Programme is a Christian leadership development initiative for women who serve the Lord in their communities. As such, the course does not lead to any academic qualification, although you will receive a certificate of ministry upon completion.

You do not have to quit your secular job to take part in this training,
