Pastor Edwina Adhiambo Owaga is a born-again Christian, a Pastor and a mother of two adults.

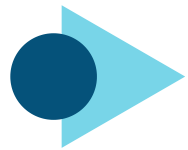

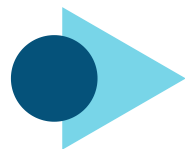
- **RECRUIT**: to enlist, as in the armed forces.

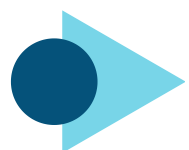

INTRODUCTION



TWO-PRONGED GOAL

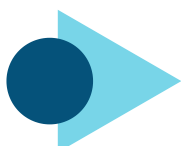

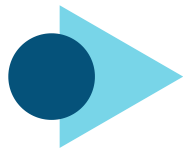

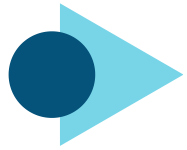
PART ONE: THE KINGDOM OF GOD

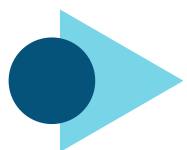


PART TWO: WALK ABOUT ZION

PART THREE: SPIRITUAL GIFTS

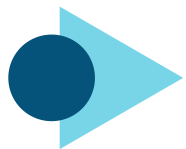
Spiritual gifts are the supernatural graces or endowments which individual believers, as well as the Corporate Church, need in order to fulfil our mission as the Church.

PART FOUR: GROWING AS LEADERS WITHIN OUR COMMUNITIES

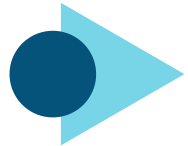
At all levels, the world is pleading for leadership - in our homes, churches, education, business, politics; in our communities, towns, cities and nations.

COURSE ASSESSMENT

- Demonstrate Personal outreach: Either reach out to other women, and believers or start a WIT community in your area of influence (workplace, university, friendship group, community, etc), and share the things you are learning with them.
- Participate in at least one WIT mission or outreach.

An attendance of 90% is REQUIRED to complete the training and obtain the certificate.

Women In Ministry Network (WiMN) is a strategic initiative that is dedicated to fostering integrity and confidence within women's ministry.

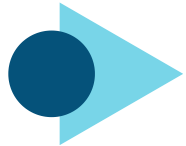
WiMN was established to address the critical need for affirmation and enhanced credibility and accountability among women in ministry.

WiMN offers a defined pathway for women pursuing ministry accreditation and/or ordination, in partnership with Churches in Communities International, a UK-based organization that facilitates this process through mutual accountability.

WiMN is more than an accreditation route; it is a platform for collaboration and raising up a new standard of leadership among women in ministry. This would authenticate the ministry of women, breaking the cultural and religious barriers to foster and hasten revival.

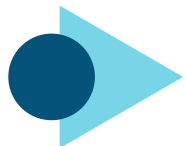
- The Training The Trainer Programme Module One is a criterion for membership of WiMN.
- Applicants who complete TTTP Module Two become eligible for ordination, after one year of WiMN membership

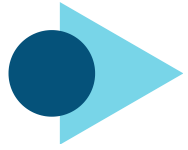

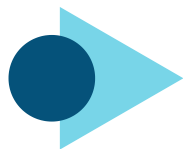

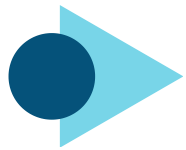
